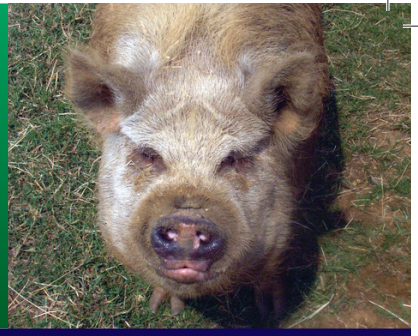

ANIMAL CARE & WELFARE

What?

If you care about animals and would like to be part of a dedicated team of professionals that care about their welfare, then a career in animal care could be for you. The industry offers a wide range of opportunities in handling, supervising and caring for animals from small domestic and exotic pets to wildlife and zoo animals. The **Animal Care & Welfare Apprenticeship** and **Advanced Apprenticeships** are delivered by Moulton College in partnership with your employer. They are ideal if you'd like practical, 'on the job training' to further your career within an animal care environment.

How?

You will attend college on a day release basis, for one day a week and spend the other four in the workplace. You will build a portfolio of evidence gained from the workplace and receive on-site assessment visits. To support you and your employer throughout your apprenticeship you will be assigned a Training Adviser, who is there to provide information, advice and guidance.

When?

There are Initial Training Periods at regular intervals throughout the year and you can start at any one of these. Before you start it will be agreed how long it should take you to achieve the qualification, but you can achieve the qualification sooner if you make sufficient progress.

Where will it take me?

Many of our Advanced Apprentices have moved into supervisory positions as a result of the skills they have acquired. You could also consider a Foundation Degree in Applied Animal Studies.

The **Apprenticeship in Animal Care** is ideal for employees who are at the beginning of their career and would like to gain a good grounding in all aspects of the animal care environment. **Moulton College offers two pathways, Animal Care and Welfare and Dog Grooming.**

- Level 2 Work-based Diploma in Animal Care
- Level 1 Functional skill in Mathematics
- Level 1 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- HSE approved Emergency First Aid.

The **Advanced Apprenticeship in Animal Care** is ideal for employees who are experienced in the animal care environment. You will need to work effectively with staff within your organisation as well as with customers and clients. **Moulton College offers two pathways, Animal Care and Welfare and Dog Grooming.**

- Level 3 Work-based Diploma in Animal Care
- Level 2 Functional skill in Mathematics
- Level 2 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- HSE approved Emergency First Aid.

Interested?

There are no formal entry requirements other than that you must be employed within the animal care industry and can gain the evidence required. You must demonstrate a commitment and enthusiasm towards your chosen apprenticeship.
