BRICKLAYING

What?

Bricklayers build and maintain a range of structures including internal and external walls on new houses and commercial projects, chimney stacks, tunnel linings and decorative work such as archways and garden walls. They also deal with the repair and refurbishment of existing brickwork or masonry. The **Bricklaying Apprenticeship** and **Advanced Apprenticeships** are delivered by Moulton College in partnership with your employer. They are ideal if you'd like practical, 'on the job training' to further your career within the construction industry.

How?

You will attend college on a day release basis, for one day a week and spend the other four in the workplace. You will build a portfolio of evidence gained from the workplace and receive on-site assessment visits. To support you and your employer throughout your apprenticeship you will be assigned a Training Adviser, who is there to provide information, advice and guidance.

When?

There are Initial Training Periods at regular intervals throughout the year and you can start at any one of these. Before you start it will be agreed how long it should take you to achieve the qualification, but you can achieve the qualification sooner if you make sufficient progress.

Where will it take me?

Many of our Advanced Apprentices have gone on to build very successful businesses with the skills they have acquired and others have moved into supervisory positions. You could also consider applying to complete a Foundation Degree in Construction Management.

The **Apprenticeship in Bricklaying** is ideal for employees who are at the beginning of their career and would like to gain a good grounding in all aspects of the bricklaying trade.

The **Advanced Apprenticeship in Bricklaying** is ideal for employees who are experienced in the construction environment and wish to pursue a supervisory role or perhaps set up their own business.

- Level 2 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities

There are no formal entry requirements other than that you must be employed within the construction industry and can gain the evidence required. You must demonstrate a commitment and enthusiasm towards your chosen apprenticeship.
