FLORISTRY

What?

Florists use creativity and knowledge of plants and flowers to design and assemble floral displays. These can be sold to the general public through shops and market stalls and can also be sold to businesses and event organisers. Florists work indoors in a workroom or shop, or outdoors if running a market stall or delivering floral arrangements to customers. The **Floristry Apprenticeship** and **Advanced Apprenticeships** are delivered by Moulton College in partnership with your employer. It's perfect if you'd like practical, 'on the job training' to further your career within the floristry industry.

How?

You will attend college on a day release basis, for one day a week and spend the other four in the workplace. You will build a portfolio of evidence gained from the workplace and receive on-site assessment visits. To support you and your employer throughout your apprenticeship you will be assigned a Training Adviser, who is there to provide information, advice and guidance.

When?

There are Initial Training Periods at regular intervals throughout the year and you can start at any one of these. Before you start it will be agreed how long it should take you to achieve the qualification, but you can achieve the qualification sooner if you make sufficient progress.

Where will it take me?

Many of our Advanced Apprentices have progressed to supervisory positions within their shop and others have gone on to start their own businesses.

The **Apprenticeship in Floristry** is ideal for employees who are at the beginning of their career and would like to gain a good grounding in all aspects of the floristry industry.

- Level 2 Work-based Diploma in Floristry
- Level 1 Functional skill in Maths
- Level 1 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- HSE approved Emergency First Aid certificate
- One other legislative qualification chosen by the employer and yourself.

The **Advanced Apprenticeship in Floristry** is ideal for employees who are experienced in floristry. You will need to work effectively with staff within your organisation as well as with customers and clients.

- Level 3 Work-based Diploma in Floristry
- Level 2 Functional skill in Maths
- Level 2 Functional skill in English
- Level 1 Functional skill in ICT
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- HSE approved Emergency First Aid certificate
- One other legislative qualification chosen by the employer and yourself.

Interested?

There are no formal entry requirements other than that you must be employed by a florist and that you are committed and enthusiastic towards your chosen apprenticeship.
