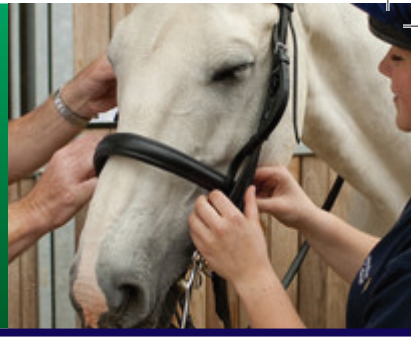

HORSE CARE

What?

This Apprenticeship is suitable for those looking to work in the equine industry. It's one of the most diverse industries within the land-based sector with opportunities for working in livery yards, riding schools, racing yards and training yards. Horses represent a major asset for their owners and need the skilled attention of devoted and well trained staff. The **Horse Care Apprenticeship** and **Advanced Apprenticeships** are delivered by Moulton College in partnership with your employer. They are ideal if you'd like practical, 'on the job training' to further your career within the equine industry.

How?

You will attend college on a day release basis, for one day a week and spend the other four in the workplace. You will build a portfolio of evidence gained from the workplace and receive on-site assessment visits. To support you and your employer throughout your apprenticeship you will be assigned a Training Adviser, who is there to provide information, advice and guidance.

When?

There are Initial Training Periods at regular intervals throughout the year and you can start at any one of these. Before you start it will be agreed how long it should take you to achieve the qualification, but you can achieve the qualification sooner if you make sufficient progress.

Where will it take me?

Many of our Advanced Apprentices have moved into supervisory positions as a result of the skills they have acquired. You could also consider the Foundation Degree in Equine Management.

The **Apprenticeship in Horse Care** is ideal for employees who are at the beginning of their career and would like to gain a good grounding in all aspects of the equine environment.

- Level 2 Work-based Diploma in Horse Care
- Level 2 Intermediate Certificate in Horse Care
- Level 1 Functional skill in Maths
- Level 1 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- One other legislative qualification chosen by the employer and yourself.

The **Advanced Apprenticeship in Horse Care** is ideal for employees who are experienced in the equine environment and have a high degree of autonomy and responsibility in their dealings with clients, customers and staff.

- Level 3 Work-based Diploma in Horse Care
- Level 3 Advanced Certificate in Horse Management
- Level 2 Functional skill in Maths
- Level 2 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- One other legislative qualification chosen by the employer and yourself.

Interested?

There are no formal entry requirements other than that you must be employed within an equine environment and that you are committed and enthusiastic towards your chosen apprenticeship.
