PLUMBING

What?

Plumbers install, maintain and repair hot and cold water supplies, sanitation and waste disposal systems, and oil, gas and solid fuel appliances and central heating. In industrial buildings and offices, plumbers also work on other piped services, such as air-conditioning and extraction systems. Outside buildings, they make weather-proofing joints in roofs and walls using sheet metals and other materials, and install gutters and drainpipes. The **Plumbing Apprenticeship** and **Advanced Apprenticeships** are delivered by Moulton College in partnership with your employer. They are perfect if you'd like practical, 'on the job training' to further your career within the plumbing industry.

How?

You will attend college on a day release basis, for one day a week and spend the other four in the workplace. You will build a portfolio of evidence gained from the workplace and receive on-site assessment visits. To support you and your employer throughout your apprenticeship you will be assigned a Training Adviser, who is there to provide information, advice and guidance.

When?

There are Initial Training Periods at regular intervals throughout the year for Apprentices and you can start at any one of these. There is an intake of Advanced Apprentices each year, in September. Before you start it will be agreed how long it should take you to achieve the qualification, but you can achieve the qualification sooner if you make sufficient progress.

Where will it take me?

Many of our Advanced Apprentices have gone on to build very successful businesses with the skills they have acquired and others have moved into supervisory positions within their company. You could also consider applying to complete a Foundation Degree in Construction Management.

The **Apprenticeship in Mechanical Engineering – Plumbing** is ideal for employees who are at the beginning of their career and would like to gain a good grounding in all aspects of the plumbing trade.

- Employment Rights and Responsibilities.

The **Advanced Apprenticeship in Mechanical Engineering – Plumbing** is ideal for employees who are experienced in the construction environment and wish to pursue a supervisory role or perhaps set up their own business.

- NVQ Level 3 in Mechanical Engineering Services
- Level 2 Functional skill in Mathematics
- Level 2 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- Core Gas Safety Assessment and Training (CCN1)
- Gas Boiler Assessment and Training (CEN1)
- Flue Analyser Assessment and Training (CPA1)

Interested?

There are no formal entry requirements other than that you must be employed within the construction industry and can gain the evidence required. You must demonstrate a commitment and enthusiasm towards your chosen apprenticeship.
