WALL & FLOOR TILING

What?

Wall and floor tilers work on jobs ranging from domestic kitchens and bathrooms to industrial premises, swimming pools, shops, hotels and offices. They work with a variety of materials including ceramics, terracotta, stone, granite, marble and adhesives, choosing the most appropriate to match the proposed use of the area, or working to technical plans drawn up by the architect or builder. The **Wall and Floor Tiling Apprenticeship** is delivered by Moulton College in partnership with your employer. It's perfect if you'd like practical, 'on the job training' to further your career within the construction industry.



How?

You will attend college on a day release basis, for one day a week and spend the other four days in the workplace. You will build a portfolio of evidence gained from the workplace and receive on-site assessment visits. To support you and your employer throughout your apprenticeship you will be assigned a Training Adviser, who is there to provide information, advice and guidance.



When?

There are Initial Training Periods at regular intervals throughout the year and you can start at any one of these. Before you start it will be agreed how long it should take you to achieve the qualification, but you can achieve the qualification sooner if you make sufficient progress.

Where will it take me?

Construction is a varied profession for which you will need to master a wide range of skills. Achievement of the Apprenticeship in Wall and Floor Tiling could lead to progression onto an Advanced Apprenticeship in Wall and Floor Tiling or you could complete an Apprenticeship in Plumbing to complement the skills you have gained. Achievement of an Advanced Apprenticeship could lead to a Foundation Degree in Construction Management.

The **Apprenticeship in Wall and Floor Tiling** is ideal for employees who are at the beginning of their career and would like to gain a good grounding in all aspects of the tiling trade.

- Level 2 Diploma in Wall and Floor Tiling
- Level 2 NVQ Diploma in Wall and Floor Tiling
- Level 1 Functional skill in Mathematics
- Level 1 Functional skill in English
- Employment Rights and Responsibilities
- Abrasive Wheels Certification
- Construction-Skills Certification Scheme (CSCS) test.

Interested?

There are no formal entry requirements other than that you must be employed by a company that can give you the tasks to obtain the evidence for wall and floor tiling. You must demonstrate commitment and enthusiasm towards your chosen Apprenticeship.
