Riders who have ever competed as a team member of any Senior International Team, (Nations Cup, World, European Championships and Olympic Games) are not eligible. Pony Riders, Children, Juniors and Young Riders who have ever competed in Nations Cup/International Team Events and European Championships in the last 5 years are not eligible.

(Excluding Veteran Teams)

Speed 325mpm. Table A7 Rule 320.

First 6 to qualify for 2010 Second Rounds. Qualification will not pass down the line and qualifiers must jump clear in the first round. Regional points will be awarded in Absolute Horse Magazine Regional League Tables.

Directions

From the South via the M1 & A43: Exit the M1 at Junction 15 and join the A508 North. After 2 miles the A508 becomes the A45. At the third intersection leave the A45 by the slip road and join the A43 (signposted Kettering). Travel for 3 miles, straight across 3 roundabouts and at the 4th turn left signposted Holcot.

Continue on this road until you reach stop sign in Holcot, turn left, leave Village heading for Moulton. About 1 mile out of Holcot you need to make a right turn onto Boughton Fair Lane (it is sign-posted but not very easy to see), at the end of the road turn right, about 100/200 yards on the Right is GATE 4 – Pitsford Site you need to come in here. If you look to your left the Equestrian Centre is across the football pitch.

By Road From the North via the A14 & A508:

Leave the A14 at Junction 2 signposted Northampton. Stay on the A508 until sign-posted Pitsford on the left, make this turning, pass through the village following signs to Moulton. On leaving Pitsford follow Moulton Road, which becomes Pitsford Road for 1.5 miles when the entrance to the Pitsford Centre will be seen on your left.

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. Entry in classes 2-5 are confirmed to Registered Horses in accordance with BSJA Rule 79.
2. Neither the Show Committee Moulton College nor the BSJA accept any responsibility or liability for any accident, damage, injury or loss to horse/pony, rider, grooms, spectators, vehicles or any other person or property WHATSOEVER.
3. The Judges decision shall be final.
4. Complaints must be made in writing and accompanied by a deposit of £25 which will be forfeited if the objections is over-ruled.
5. The Committee reserve the right to cancel or amend the order of events and to restrict entries in any one class once an acceptable number has been received.
6. Hard Hats and Correct Dress must be worn at all times **WHILST** mounted.
7. In the event of insufficient entries, lower prizes may be withheld in accordance with Rule 76.
8. Any entries can be refused at the discretion of the Show Committee.
9. No entry will be accepted without the appropriate fee.
10. By making an entry it is acknowledged that riders are taking part in a risk sport and that they are competent to ride at the level of competition that they have entered.
11. No member shall allow a stallion for which he/she is responsible as owner lessee authorised agent or rider to compete or be prepared to compete in any show jumping competition without taking adequate precautions to ensure other members of the public are not put at risk or injury. Rule no. 82-21. Stallions are NOT allowed to compete in the "Ticket to Ride Scheme".
