Overview

Stonemasonry is a specialist craft and as a stonemason, you would use your skills to carve architectural features, cut and shape blocks.

As a banker mason you would follow design instructions to carve and shape stone and give it a textured or polished finish (known as dressing), using hand and power tools.

As a heritage stonemason you will specialise in preparing backgrounds to prepare stone cladding and learn how to conserve and restore existing brickwork using heritage techniques.
