When you finish your GCSEs you get to decide if you want to remain in school or progress on to a vocational course, T Level or apprenticeship at college.

Only you can decide what is the best option for you but here are the main features of each pathway to help you.

At Moulton College we offer BTEC courses, apprenticeships and T Levels.



A-Levels



Study 3-4 subjects over two years



Assessment by examinations and sometimes course work



Predominantly classroom based



Entry requirements typically 5 GCSEs at grade 9-4 but can be higher

Not currently available to study at Moulton College

BTECs



Specialist, work-related qualifications



Typically focus on one subject



Combine practical learning with subject and theory content



Assessed by coursework and practical assessments rather than just examinations

Likely to include some work experience as part of the course



T Levels

-  New, two-year courses that follow on from GCSEs and are equivalent to 3 A-Levels
-  Designed with employers and businesses
-  Aim to prepare students for work, further training or study
-  Mixture of classroom and 'on the job training' during an industry placement of approximately 45 days
-  Entry requirements similar to A-Levels and Level 3 BTEC qualifications

Apprenticeships

-  Employed to do a real job while studying for a formal qualification
-  Typically one day a week at college and the rest of the time in the workplace
-  Earn a salary while you complete your studies
-  Available at various levels with different entry requirements depending on the level / employer's requirements



T-LEVELS

T Levels are a brand new type of qualification that is replacing some BTEC vocational courses.

The new courses have been developed in consultation with employers and people working in the industry to make sure that the content is relevant to the skills that employers need you to learn for the future.

T Levels are equivalent to three A-Levels and you can still earn UCAS points and progress on to university.

The key difference is that you will spend approximately 20% of your time on a work placement – that's 45 days per year! This enables you to put what you're learning in to practice and means you can build important contacts for the future.

Apprenticeships are a great way to earn while you learn! You will have a real job working for a company who will provide you with on-the-job training.

Alongside this you will spend approximately 20% of your time doing off-the-job training. This might be one day a week at college or maybe a block release of a number of weeks.

Throughout your training you are a member of staff, entitled to paid holidays and other benefits.

It can be hard work to combine your studies with a job but for many people apprenticeships offer the opportunity to start working straight away.

Supporting you all the way

Our support services and facilities are available to you throughout your time with us. Our Student Services team can help you with course choices, financial support, and transport.

If you need additional learning support due to a disability, sensory impairment, learning difficulty, or medical condition, we can make changes and provide equipment to suit you.

Our safeguarding and wellbeing team are available to offer emotional and pastoral support and referrals to specialist agencies as needed.

Our residential wardens are available on-site providing our residential students with practical advice and support.

Personal Development Tutors (PDTs)

You will have a lesson a week with your assigned PDT, focusing on your wellbeing and other topics to get you ready for the wider world. You can also access the team for support, advice, guidance and signposting to a range of services available to all our students.

Careers Team

The Careers Team are located on the first floor of the Learning Hub and provide a service all students can access to support their future steps. You can book a one-to-one confidential appointment with a qualified Careers Advisor to help you plan your career and future study pathway.

Library Services

The Library Services Team are also located on the first floor of the Learning Hub. They have a wide range of books and e-resources to help you complete your course. The team can also help you with study skills such as referencing and research, either face-to-face or online.

Enrichment

Enrichment activities could be visits and speakers as part of your course or cross-college events such as community projects where you can make new friends and gain valuable experience for beyond college. We encourage all students to give something a go and see where it might take you.

Our College - Our Voice

As a student at Moulton College you automatically become a Student Representative. We want all students to have the opportunity to celebrate successes and raise any concerns they might have and feel listened to by the college to help resolve them.

Our College Council is elected by other students. They work directly with leaders in the College to explore cross-college issues and common themes which could have been raised by their peers. Really make your voice heard and apply to join the Council early in the academic year.





Fees and funding

Free courses

If you are 16 – 18 years old, you will not pay for any course or exam fees. If you are over 19 years old, you may have to pay, depending on your personal circumstances and existing qualifications.

Additional costs

Depending on your course, you may need to buy uniform or specialist equipment for courses and to take part in trips. You can apply for financial support from one of our student funds or bursaries.

Student bursaries

We have a limited amount of student bursaries to help you pay for essential equipment and uniform. Our student services team will be able to advise you about financial support.

Help with travel costs

If you are studying a full-time course, are aged 16-18 and live further than three miles from your campus you can sign up to receive subsidised travel from your local authority. If your household income is less than £30,000 per year, we can offer a travel bursary up to £660.

Thomas Harrison Trust and Sir Thomas White Charity

We can award bursaries from both these organisations to Northampton-based students with a household income of less than £25,000 per year.

Advanced Learner Loans

If you are 19+ looking to study at Level 3 or Level 4 you may be eligible for an Advanced Learner Loan. Our student services team will be able to advise you about financial support.

Advanced Learner Loan bursaries

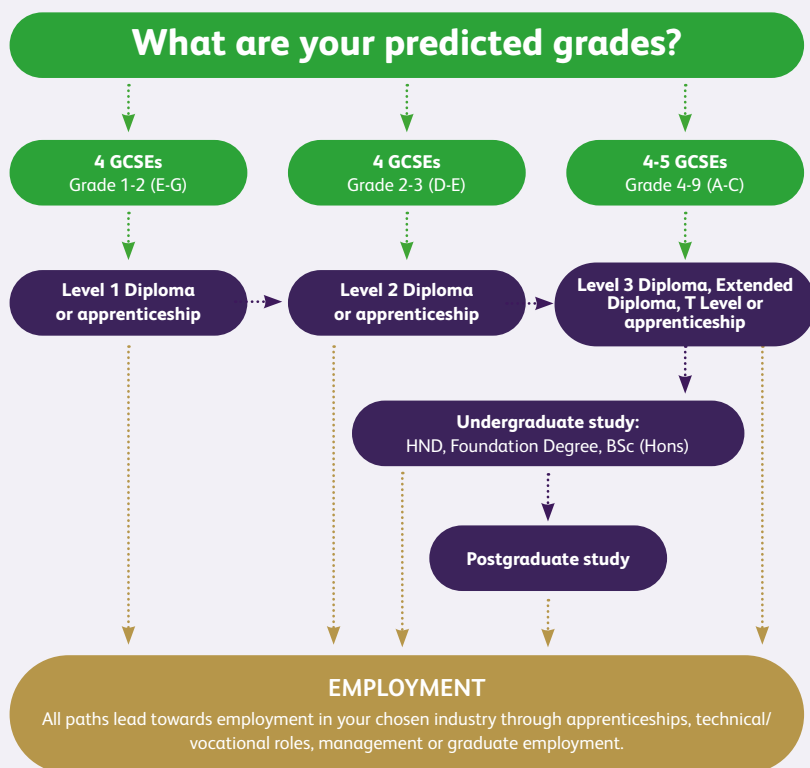
If you are accepted for an Advanced Learner Loan you can apply for this bursary to help with childcare, travel, or accommodation costs.

Course levels

Depending on your GCSE grades you may be able to enter some courses at a higher level, however for some skill-based courses you will start at a lower level to learn key skills.

Progression: As part of your pastoral sessions, you will learn how to apply to university, write a C.V., and perform your best at job interviews and more.

GCSE English & maths: If you do not achieve a grade 4 (C) or above you will study GCSE English and/or maths alongside your vocational programme or apprenticeship.
