The second year embodies practicals utilising biomechanics technology for research as well as conducting rehabilitation plans. The industry project module, builds on your skills gained in the enterprise module and the use of our first class rehabilitation facilities, enables you to gain experience utilising a variety of rehabilitation methods for future employment.
