



This qualification is aimed at adults aged 19+ wishing to gain the knowledge required at Level 3 to commence a career within the plumbing and heating sector.

What will I learn on the course?

This qualification covers topics to do with health & safety, planning and supervision, cold and hot water systems design and central heating systems, as well as sanitation, rainwater and environmental systems.

What will this course cost me?

Course cost: £3,345

To secure your place on this course a non-refundable deposit must be paid. You may be able to apply for funding or an Advanced Learning Loan towards the cost of this course, depending upon your circumstances at the start of the course. Payment plans are also available.

Free Courses for Jobs

You may be eligible to study this course for free under the Free Courses For Jobs scheme if you meet the following criteria:

- Are aged 19-23 and do not already have a level 3 qualification
- Already have a level 3 qualification or higher, but earn a salary of below of £25,750pa
- Already have a level 3 qualification or higher but are unemployed
- Meet funding residency requirements and course entry level requirements
