Adult English courses are delivered on Wednesday evenings.

This course gives anybody over the age of 19, without a formal English qualification, the opportunity to develop their key reading, writing and speaking & listening skills and work towards a recognised national qualification.

What will I learn on the course?

Adult English courses cover a range of key skills:

- Reading and analysing a variety of texts
- Writing accurately for different purposes
- Taking part in discussions
- Delivering presentations

What will this course cost me?

You do not have to pay any fees for this course.

What does a typical week look like?

You will need to attend college on a Wednesday evening, 6pm - 8pm. You will also need to complete further self-directed study during the week which will be set by the tutor and may include use of online resources.

How will I be assessed?

All English courses are assessed by two final exams and internal speaking & listening assessments.

Where can it lead to?

A GCSE grade 4 or Functional Skills Level 2 are the minimum requirement for most courses at Level 3 and above. Many employers also require these qualifications to evidence the skills considered vital in the modern workplace.

What are the entry requirements for this course?

Anyone aged 19 and over, without a grade 4 or C in GCSE English.

You will need to complete a detailed assessment before the course so that we can establish your current English knowledge and skills.
