What you'll learn

Carpentry and Joinery students will learn the basics of wood work fixtures and fittings. We will teach you the health and safety aspects of working in a workshop as well as the proper preparation and maintenance of the tools you will use on a daily basis. You will learn to produce high quality work in a safe environment that encourages creativity. You will cover modules including:

- Health, safety and welfare in construction An overview of the regulations and expectations within the construction industry.
- Principles of building construction, information and communication An insight into the different aspects of the construction industry.
- Maintain and use carpentry and joinery hand tools How to identify faults, keep tools sharp and how to use them safely and effectively.
- Prepare and use carpentry and joinery portable power tools How to identify faults, change blades/tooling and how to use them safely and effectively.
- Produce woodworking joints- Identifying suitable joints for their purpose. Using the different tools available, setting out and constructing a range of different joints.

What will this course cost me?
